**Rules for One Year LL.M.  
(From the Academic Year 2016-17)**

1. One year LL.M course shall be of 24 credits in a year and the same shall be divided in to two semesters with 12 credits each.
2. The students shall opt for the specialization at the time of commencement of the first semester.
3. The first Semester shall consist of four papers of three credits each as under -

DL-101 Research Methodology and Legal Writing

DL-102 Comparative Public law

DL-103 Law and Justice in a Globalised World

One paper from each specialization group (DL-104, DL- 105, DL-106, DL-107, DL-108)

4. The second semester shall be of 12 credits and it shall consist of two papers with three credits each from the specialization group and one soft paper from any group along with the dissertation with three credits. The dissertation shall consist of two credits for written dissertation work and one credit for viva voce.
5. Each paper shall carry three credits and the same is divided as under-
  - 40 marks** – Semester end Written Examination
  - 35 marks** – Internal Assessment
6. The internal assessment of 35 marks for the first semester shall consist of the following-
  - 10 marks** – LTP (Long Term Paper) in any two subjects of the semester (In remaining two subjects students shall write additional question/s of 10 marks in internal written test)
  - 10 marks** – Tutorials
  - 10 marks** – Internal written test
  - 05 marks** – Viva voce test- to be conducted jointly by the subject teacher concerned and another teacher appointed by the Head of the Department form the Faculty of the Department, for about 15 minutes per student.

7. The dissertation shall consist of two credits for written work and one credit for viva voce. The Viva voce shall be conducted by the panel of examiners consisting of the Head of Department, Guide and the external examiner.
8. The internal assessment of 35 marks for the two subjects of the specialization groups and one soft paper for the second semester shall consist of the following –
  - 20 marks** – Internal written test
  - 10 marks** - Tutorial/seminar presentation
  - 05 marks** – Viva voce test (to be conducted jointly by the subject teacher and another teacher appointed by the Head of Department)
9. At the beginning of each academic year, the Head, Department of Law shall notify the optional courses (specializations) in which instruction will be available during the academic year. No regular candidate is permitted to opt for courses not so notified.
10. A student shall be granted the term for the course concerned if he/she has put in an attendance of not less than 85% of the lectures and tutorials separately.
