1. Hard copy of the application form should be sent to The Head, Department of Statistics & Centre for Advanced Studies, Savitribai Phule Pune University , Pune 411007.
2. Final year B.Sc. students are eligible to appearing for the entrance examination.

3. Savitribai Phule Pune University students should have passed the qualifying examination of the University. They should be domicile of the State of Maharashtra or should have Completed Maharashtra State Board of Secondary School Certificate Education (S.S.C.) and Higher Education (H.S.C.) from the State of Maharashtra Board. They should have fulfilled the eligibility criteria laid down by the University, from time to time.
4. **Admission through Entrance Examination:** Equal weightage shall be given to the marks obtained in the University Entrance Examination and the qualifying examination. In case of the students other than the students of the Savitribai Phule Pune University, the admission shall be made on the basis of marks obtained in the Entrance Examination only.
5. 70% seats are reserved for the Savitribai Phule Pune University students and 30% seats are reserved for the other University students of the total intake.
