**ADMISSION NOTIFICATION**

In continuation with university notification dated 30 April, 2019 applications are invited from the eligible candidates who having valid GATE score for the admission to the M. Tech (Energy Technology).

**Qualifying Exam and Eligibility:**

- Should have B.E/ B. Tech. degree with Valid GATE Score.

**Important Note:**

- Total number of seats for the course are 20.
- Seats will be filled as per the merit list of Valid GATE score. Any vacant seats will be filled through the University Entrance Examination conducted on June 16, 2019.
- Students having VALID GATE SCORE will be eligible for the stipend of Rs 12,400/- per month under National Renewable Energy Fellowship (NREF) Programme of Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE), Government of India, after the sanction and release of funds from MNRE. Candidates without valid GATE score are not eligible for fellowship.

**Reservation:**

- Reservation in admission of students to various Post-Graduate/Graduate/Integrated/ Interdisciplinary courses shall be as per the norms laid down by the Government of Maharashtra from time to time including reservation for the person with disabilities/Orphan and Defence Personnel's Child/Ex-Serviceman Child.
- 30% seats are reserved for female candidates for Under Graduate courses as per Government of Maharashtra Rules.
- Reservation for SBC category as per Government of Maharashtra rules.

**Supernumerary Quota:**

- Supernumerary quota for admission to the above courses shall be as per the provision of Ordinance 181-A amended, University Order. (Circular No. PGS/1821 dated 14/06/2019).
- In case of candidates who want to seek admission under supernumerary quota, it is necessary to submit appropriate documents at the time of admission

**Fees and Mode of Payment :**

- Following fee is applicable :
  - a) For candidates belonging to General category : Rs. 500/-
  - b) For candidates belonging to Reserved categories : Rs. 350/-
- Payment should be made online using Debit/Credit Card/Net Banking etc.

**Instructions for Filling Online Application:**

- Online application form is available on the website: <https://campus.unipune.ac.in/ccep/login.aspx>

- Required Documents: Candidate shall upload the following documents with the application:
  - a) Photocopy of valid GATE score card.
  - b) Photo-copy of the statement of marks of the qualifying examination passed, if applicable (which is required for the eligibility.)
  - c) Photo-copy of the caste certificate in case of Reserved category candidates (if applicable).
  - d) Photo-copy of the Non-creamy layer certificate in case of Reserved category (OBC/DTNT/SBC/EWS/SEBC/Women) candidates (if applicable).
  - e) Photo copy of the Medical certificate issued by the Civil Surgeon in case of 'Persons with disabilities (P.H.)' candidates (if applicable).
- Candidates are NOT required to submit printout of application/documents to the University after online submission of application. However, these documents in original have to be submitted to the respective Department at the time of admission.
- Incomplete applications/ applications without uploading required documents/ applications submitted after the last date will be rejected without assigning any reason and no correspondence will be entertained by the University in this regard.
- No request for change in any information provided in the online form will be entertained by the University.

**General Instructions:**

- In case of any grievance of disputes the decision of the admission committee shall be final and binding on all.
- Admission to any program does not guarantee Hostel facility or any kind of financial support in any form like Scholarship, fellowship, Earn & Learn etc. The University has independent procedure for offering such benefits.
- Various scholarships by Government(s) shall be admissible as per prescribed rules in this regards.
- It is the responsibility of the applicant to fulfil the eligibility conditions and comply with the admission requirements. If at any stage it is notice that a falls claim has been made by the candidate or important material facts have been concealed and / or the candidate is not eligible, his candidature shall be liable for cancellation at any stage.
