Q.1 Who can apply for (M.Sc. Physics) examination ?

Ans. – B.Sc. degree in any of the following subjects or combination: Physics, Electronics Science, Chemistry and Mathematics. **Mathematics at SY level of B.Sc. is essential.** Or B.E. / B. Tech. / B.S. (any branch) passed or final year appeared student can apply for entrance test.

Q.2 How can I apply?

Ans. – You can apply online. Application form are available on <http://physics.unipune.ac.in> or <http://campus.unipune.ac.in/Default.aspx>

Q.3 What is date and time of entrance examination?

Ans. – Sunday, 3rd June 2018, Time 2.00 pm to 5.00 pm

Q.4 Which are the examination centers?

Ans. – Pune, Mumbai, Nashik, Ahmednagar, Sangli, Dhule, Nagpur, New Delhi, Kolkata & Bangalore (10 Centers) (tentative list, Actual centers will depend on the number of application opting for a centre)

Q.5 Can I change my examination center?

Ans. – Yes, you can change your examination center before last date of online submission by writing an application to Head of the Department through an e-mail (hod@physics.unipune.ac.in) or hard copy, with proper justification.

Q.6 What is last date of submission of online application form?

Ans. – 25th May 2018

Q.7 Which documents should be attached with duly filled application form?

Ans. – The application process is online only. Hence hard copies of any documents (online filled form/fees receipt) should **NOT** be submitted to the Department of Physics . Instead they should be kept safely with you in case they are required for any future communication.

Q.8 Who is considered a student of Savitribai Phule Pune University?

Ans. – A student who has passed B.Sc. from Savitribai Phule Pune University and is domicile of State of Maharashtra. Domicile certificate is essential or a student who has passed B.Sc. from Savitribai Phule Pune University and 10th and 12th Examination from State of Maharashtra passed .

Q.9 What is the Intake capacity?

Ans. – 90

Q.10 What is the percentage of reservation?

Ans. – 50% reservation for Backward Class Students having domicile of Maharashtra state (no reservation for other state students) and having caste certificate issued by competent authority. Open – 50% Category – 50% (**SC: 13%, ST: 7.0%, DT - A: 3.0%, NT - B: 2.5%, NT - C: 3.5%, NT - D: 2.0% , OBC : 19 %**)(as per the norms of Govt. of Maharashtra at the time admission)

Q.11 Who will need Non-Creamy Layer certificate?

Ans. – Students belonging to OBC,DT-A,NT-B, NT-C,NT-D & SBC category need to upload non-creamy layer certificate (Old/New).

Q.12 What are other reservations?

Ans. –Over and above the approved intake : (i) 3% seats are reserved for physically challenged persons (Indian nationality),(ii) 5% seats are reserved for Ex-Serviceman's/ active defense person is child of Indian Nationality,(iii) 3% of seats shall be reserved for the students participating at the National level/State level/University level Sports and Cultural competitions,(iv) one seat reserved for Jammu & Kashmir migrant student, as per the merit in the entrance test ,in the said category and subject to availability.

Q.13 What is the procedure for admission of international student?

Ans. – The admission procedure will be followed by International centre, Savitribai Phule Pune University, for details contact – The Director, International Student centre, Savitribai Phule Pune University, Ganeshkhind, Pune – 411007. Q.14 Who will need gap certificate?

Ans. – A student who has gap in the education after B.Sc. degree/B.E. degree.

Q.15 How can I generate my hall ticket?

Ans.- You can generate your hall ticket from 29th May 2018 onwards by using your login ID and Password, that you have used to fill in your application form. Please remember the Login ID and Password.

Q.16 – What documents need to be produced along with hall ticket at the time of entrance examination?

Ans. – Any one Photo ID Proof like pan card / AADHAR Card / PASSPORT / DRIVING LICENCE etc.

Q.17 What is the syllabus for entrance test?

Ans.- B.Sc. (Physics) 3 Years Syllabus

Q.18 What is the format of Question Paper ?

Ans.- The question paper will consist of multiple choice questions. Total 50 objective questions. The correct Answer carries +3 (positive three marks), incorrect Answer -1 (negative one mark) and unattempted question 0 marks.

Q.19 Can I get previous year's entrance exam question papers?

Ans. – No.

Q.20 Is answer key declared?

Ans. – No.

Q.21 Is hostel facility available?

Ans. – Yes, (Limited Seats) Hostel is available on the basis of merit only.

Q.22 When will merit list be declared?

Ans. – Other state students and Maharashtra state (Other than Savitribai Phule Pune University) students merit list will be declared tentatively within 15 days after entrance examination. The result will be declared on Department of Physics website. For Savitribai Phule Pune University's student after the declaration of B.Sc. result.

Q.23 When will the course start?

Ans. – 16th July, 2018.
